



## Bus Tour—The Heart of the Scenic Rim Tuesday 10 March 2009



Our day commences at Rosevale with morning tea and a guided tour of the area including historic **St Patrick's Church**. Next stop is the **Rosevale Retreat Hotel**, near Aratula, which is possibly Queensland's oldest surviving pub, built over 150 years ago in 1852. After the 1893 floods the hotel was moved from the banks of the Black Gully Creek a mile away to its present site by two teams of 14 bullocks, and during the 5 day move it never ceased trading. Well known and loved for its country fresh food and tender local beef it's the perfect place to enjoy lunch on our day trip. The hotel also featured in four of Australian film maker Charles Chauvel's 1920's movies. On the way back to Brisbane we are invited to view **Booval House, Ipswich**, a privately owned rare Queensland example of two-story Colonial Georgian architecture built in the 1850's for George Faircloth and family.
